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The Forestias to include Six Senses hotel, club

Six Senses Hotels Resorts Spas will operate a 60-bedroom hotel at The Forestias, a THB90bn (US\$2.8bn), 119-acre green development at Bangna in Bangkok being developed by Magnolia Quality Development Corporation Limited (MQDC).

The project is a mixed-use, multi-generational lifestyle project that will also incorporate a large forest ecosystem. Set to open in 2022, The Forestias will include residential housing, retail, office buildings, a health centre, innovation centre, forest pavilion, community space and learning centre.

Foster + Partners has provided consultancy on the architectural master plan; Six Senses will provide hospitality and residential management, as well as the hotel group's first membership club in Asia; and the Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health will conduct scientific research and data collection on the

impact of the project's landscape and design features on human health.

"Today, innovation and technology play a significant role in the economy; they connect living and lifestyle together," said Visit Malaisirirat, CEO of MQDC. "Amidst materialistic advancement, the world is

challenged in many ways – the natural ecosystem is deteriorating, families are drifting apart creating distance between people, leading to feelings of isolation and depression, and society is ageing fast. Our company is committed to developing real estate projects to close the gap and bring sustainable happiness with a promise of 'for all wellbeing.'

The Forestias is based on four core elements to create happiness: '50 Shades of Nature' – happiness from living amid nature; 'Connecting 4 Generations' – happiness from being with family members across

four generations; 'Community of Dreams' – happiness from space and facilities that allow people to connect and with each other; and 'Sustainnovation for Wellbeing' – technology and innovation that drive sustainability and promote health and wellbeing.

Architects named for Half Moon Bay

Dutch architects Studio Piet Boon and Florida-based firm OBMI have been selected to design the Half Moon Bay, a Rosewood hotel and residential community on the Caribbean island of Antigua.

Set to occupy 132 acres of uninhabited land, the new beachfront getaway will feature 47 suites and several Rosewood-branded villas, as well as 10 purchasable luxury estate lots – all of which will be anchored around a 'retail village'.

Further amenities will include tennis courts, pools, spas, and a biodynamic farm.

Speaking on the project, Piet Boon, founder of the same-named studio called it a "once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to create something enduring".

Bill Green, managing director of Replay Resorts – which is developing the property – said the landscape experience at Half Moon Bay would emulate nature by revolving around the "stewardship of the land".

Set to open in 2021, Rosewood Half Moon Bay will feature 47 pavilion-style suites, including a three-bedroom presidential suite, and will be flanked by a collection of Rosewood Residences. The site of the Half Moon Bay Antigua was previously home to Half Moon Bay Resort, built on Antigua back in the 1950s. The resort was frequented by notable names like Audrey Hepburn and Elton John, helping to establish the area as a celebrity hot spot.

Butterflies inspire Vietnamese spa

Vietnamese interior design company Module K have turned an old building into a luxurious spa in Vietnam, using a curved concrete staircase designed like a silk ribbon, angled glass panes to bring in light and a stylised butterfly wing exterior facade.

The Shynh House Centre - Beauty Cosmetic & Spa is located at a busy intersection in HCMC set among rows of trees and the typical

Vietnamese jumble of building styles and cables. The five-storey building had a typical office façade with small windows, and Module K decided to create a new layer that acts as a screen and filter – a “second skin” – covering the entire face with a standalone system. This facade concept is a series of layers of membranes and perforated metal to evoke the idea of a butterfly; the butterfly motif also reappears in details such as door handles and mirrors.

The laser-cut perforated aluminium exterior screen filters the light and views and brings an atmosphere of silence and beauty to the interior spaces. At night, the building lights up like a lantern to showcase its transformation into

a sculpture. In order to bring natural daylight and ventilation to the space, a series of courtyards was cut into the building and wrapped with curved glass. These angled glass walls enhance the outlook of the tree canopy, and limit the view of outside wiring. The floors and treatment rooms gently curve and create alternating open and intimate spaces.

“The brand identity as well as the look and feel of the building is derived from the idea of transformation, and expressed as stylised butterfly wings. The butterfly becomes the DNA of the building,” said Jade Nguyen Kim Ngoc, design director of Module K.

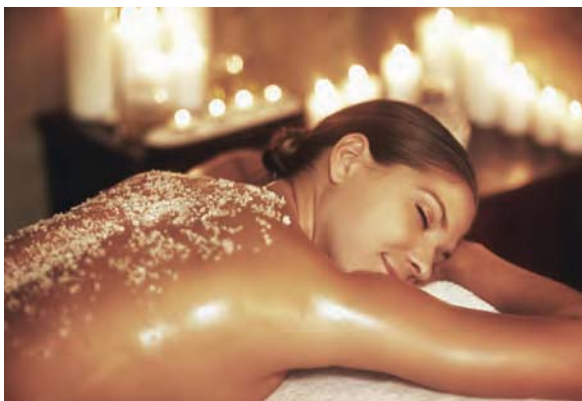

Wellness destination Chiva-Som reopens after six-month renovation

Thai wellness destination Chiva-Som reopened on 1 November after a six-month closure to complete the third of four stages of the resort's first major renovation since its opening 23 years ago.

The latest aesthetic and hardware developments include a complete overhaul of the Thai Pavilions, Emerald Room, Orchid Lounge, Library, Fitness Centre and Niranlada Medi-Spa.

The refurbishment is being overseen by Krip Rojanastien, chair and CEO of Chiva-Som International Health Resort, who together with architecture firm Designrealization Siam Co. Ltd, has developed a modern and fresh take on the wellness destination. In line with the resort master plan, the hallmarks of which are contemporary and comfortable interiors, the new look is realised with materials such as local sustainable teak, silk and bamboo.

The Fitness Centre has increased in size to incorporate a larger gym area and a separate stretching space with an array of new cardio equipment, functional and non-functional training equipment as well as a private training room and two fully renovated dance and Pilates studios. The Kinesis Room has been renamed the Re-functional Studio, home to a private Neurac Room, Functional Assessment room and boasting brand new equipment including a BIODEX 4 PRO Isokinetic Dynamometer to help with rehabilitation, leg mobility and balance, as well as preparing the body for more strenuous exercise. The Niranlada Medi-Spa has evolved from its original clinical design to become warm and tranquil.

Champney's appoints architect for spa

UK spa operator Champneys has appointed Darling Associates to provide the designs for a £10m redevelopment of the historic Mottram Hall, which it acquired in September 2018.

The Grade II-listed, 18th century building in Cheshire, UK, currently comprises a hotel, spa and golf course in addition to conference and events facilities. Built in 1721 by Nathaniel Booth, Mottram Hall was first converted into a hotel in 1940 and features formal gardens which are surrounded by 270 acres of parkland.

Champneys intends to turn the property into a luxury spa resort, with plans including a 20m swimming pool, 18 new treatment rooms and wet and thermal experiences.

There are also plans to increase the number of bedrooms to 150 and add new conference facilities and an extension to the clubhouse on the Championship golf course.

Construction on site is expected to commence in 2019.

"Mottram Hall gives our brand a broader geographical spread with a presence in the North-West," said owner Stephen Purdew. "It's a fantastic property and we're delighted to be adding it to our collection of properties within the Champneys Group. We're now planning a considerable investment property which will take place over the next year."
