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Lefay confirms second location to open in 2019

Destination spa Lefay has announced plans for a second location, Lefay Resort and Spa Dolomiti, in the ski region of Madonna di Campiglio, Italy. Set in the Italian Dolomite mountains, the resort is due to open in 2019, and will include 84 suites and a 5,000sq m (54,000sq ft) wellbeing area. Swimming pools, relaxation areas, saunas, a fitness zone and numerous treatment rooms will all be included in the spa, which is set to be one of the largest in the Alpine region. The company also revealed that a third Lefay location is being planned in Tuscany, and that it will explore expansion in central Europe in cooperation with select partners.

The Dolomitti resort will also introduce the concept of Lefay Wellness Residences, with 25 homes starting at 100sq m (1,076sq ft) and with direct access to the wellness area and two restaurants.

“With Lefay Resort and Spa Dolomiti, the brand strengthens its identity, characterised by the reinterpretation of the concept of luxury and a holistic wellbeing philosophy,” said Liliana Leali, Lefay Resort CEO. “Sustainability, Italian spirit and a unique wellness method are the core values of Lefay

Collection, and in 2019, they will also be found in one of the most fascinating mountain destinations in Italy. We’re very excited about this opening and ready to face a new challenge, with the certainty that it will also be a new opportunity for new projects and resources within the local community.”

Designed by Italian architecture firm Alberto Apostoli, the resort blends into the surrounding landscape and will reinterpret local traditional architecture, using elements such as stone and wood.

The resort will have a focus on sustainability, and will be supplied by renewable energy sources and certified by ClimaHotel. Similarly to Lefay Resort & Spa Lago di Garda, the property in the Dolomites will also be committed to the neutralisation of its own emissions.

McCann heading up Lanserhof UK sites

Sheila McCann, the general manager of Thailand’s well-known Chiva-Som spa, is moving to the UK to head up two sites that form part of the ever-expanding portfolio of Austria-based health and medical resort specialists the Lanserhof Group.

One location is an urban health centre in the heart of London that’s expected to open by the end of this year. Lanserhof has partnered with the Dover Street Arts Club, a private club in Mayfair, and will be launching a ‘medical gym’ in a building opposite to it.

Billed as the ‘ultimate medical and gym facility’, it will be staffed by Lanserhof doctors and health professionals, and both Lanserhof clients and Arts Club members alike will be able to access medical advice and treatments.

The facility will feature a gym, class studios, consulting and treatment rooms, cryotherapy treatment chambers and diagnostic and medical facilities, as well as healthy food options.

The other location McCann will oversee as general manager is Grayshott Health Spa, a historic destination spa in Surrey, south England.

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Details revealed for new Six Senses

The Six Senses Kaplankaya luxury resort, located close to the Turkish resort town of Bodrum, will reopen in May following a comprehensive redesign by New York-based studio Clodagh Design.

Located across the bay from Bodrum, the 141-bedroom resort is carved into rock formations and initially opened as Canyon Ranch Kaplankaya in July 2016. An attempted Turkish coup d'état just two weeks after the resort's opening, however, made for challenging timing, and Six Senses took over the management of the property in May 2017.

Originally designed by Barcelona-based OAB architects, the resort – which is owned by Capital Partners of Turkey – has now been reimagined and “brought in line with Six Senses design, sustainability and wellness standards”. Clodagh's design pays homage to Turkish tradition, and guests arriving at the resort will walk through a lantern-lit portal and wooden doors into a sky-lit lobby, which offers views of the remaining four floors and the sea.

Following the redesign, the resort will be home to one of the most extensive and advanced spa and wellness offerings within the Six Senses portfolio. Entry to the 10,000sq m (107,640sq ft) spa will be through a seven-metre (23-foot) meditation walk.

The spa is spread over two floors and features 20 treatment rooms. The spa will also be the first property to launch the Six Senses Holistic Anti-ageing clinic, led by neuroscientist Dr Claudia Aguirre.

Major renovation for Limassol spa

After an estimated €70m (US\$83m, £62m) renovation, the Parklane resort – previously the Le Meridien Limassol – is set to reopen this summer in Cyprus. Now part of Marriott's Luxury Collection, the Cypriot resort is well-known for its thalassotherapy offerings, which will continue to be a focal point for the 3,000sq m (32,291sq ft) Kalloni Spa.

Inspired by the healing powers of the ocean, Parklane's Kalloni Spa will

offer 14 treatment rooms, two of which will be alfresco with views over the Mediterranean Sea. Two outdoor and two indoor seawater pools will be available, with thalassotherapy forming the basis of the spa's treatments, drawing from the beneficial properties of the sea and marine environment for overall health and wellbeing.

The spa will also include three private suites, two of which have Russian banyas, consisting of a sauna and ice-cold plunge pool. The Kalloni Suite will provide guests with two treatment

beds, a private plunge pool overlooking the sea and bespoke spa programmes. The spa will partner with skincare brands Voya, Biologique Recherche, Symmetria and Gentlemen's Tonic.

“Extensive research and significant investment has gone into creating the Kalloni Spa concept at Parklane, and we are delighted to finally be able to unveil its diverse and exciting offering,” said Paris Kounoudis, director of lifestyle at Parklane.

Scottish Kohler Waters Spa reopens

Kohler Waters Spa at the Old Course Hotel in St Andrews, Scotland has reopened following an extensive multi-million refurbishment. The 25,000sq ft (2,300sq m) spa is the only Kohler Waters Spa outside the US, and focuses on hydrotherapy and organic treatments, with signature wet treatment rooms and Vichy showers.

The new Kohler Waters Spa provides a 'spa' in the true meaning of the word, offering 'Salus Per Aquum' – 'health

through water'. Guests can indulge in the healing effects of water, from a hydrotherapy pool providing therapeutic bathing, a cold plunge pool and a refreshing ice fountain to experience showers featuring Kohler Real Rain.

The renovation has seen the addition of a new 20m (65.6ft) lap pool as part of the large health and fitness centre, as well as a gym area with cardio and resistance stations, a functional fitness space and a group exercise studio, with instructor-led classes along with virtual training. Mallorcan monastery hotel adds spa

Vietnam's Fusion Resort relaunches with new name



Adare Manor gets refurb, new spa

Adare Manor, Country Limerick's historic hotel and golf resort, has re-opened its doors after a multi-million-euro redevelopment, planned to establish a "new legacy" as Ireland's leading luxury resort.

Led by ReardonSmith Architects, the large-scale project has included the creation of new buildings – including a spa – as well as the restoration and refurbishment of existing properties, joined by interconnecting spaces.

Meanwhile, the repair and enhancement of the surrounding 840-acre estate – complete with manicured lawns, newly planted trees and mature parkland – has been designed by ReardonSmith Landscape.

Guests enter via an ornate new gatehouse, inspired by an earlier historic entrance. A winding driveway takes them past the tidal River Maigue and a 13th Century castle ruin, before the main Gothic manor house comes into view.

Adare Manor was originally built in the mid-19th Century and design flourishes include gargoyles, symbols of heraldry and elaborate stone and wood carvings. These have been restored by the architects, along with the vaulted arches of the lobby.
