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The Retreat at Blue Lagoon Iceland now open

The world-famous Blue Lagoon in Iceland has undergone a significant expansion with the opening of its first luxury offering, the Retreat at Blue Lagoon Iceland, which includes a hotel, restaurant and spa.

A four-year endeavour, the Retreat is the result of a partnership between Blue Lagoon; Basalt Architects, the firm that designed the complex and made significant contributions to its interior design; and Design Group Italia, the agency that conceived and orchestrated the Retreat's interior, experiential, and product design.

The project includes the subterranean Retreat Spa, the geothermal Retreat Lagoon, the 62-suite Retreat Hotel, and the Moss Restaurant.

Built into an 800-year-old lava flow on the south shore of the Blue Lagoon, the Retreat Spa is offered to both overnight guests of the Retreat and day guests, and features

a steamroom built into the lava rock; a cold well; in-water massages; treatment rooms offering bench massages and beauty treatments; and a spa restaurant.

Exclusive to the Retreat is the Blue Lagoon Ritual, a spacious area of interconnected chambers where guests cover their bodies with

the three treasures of geothermal seawater – silica, algae and minerals.

The Retreat Spa also allows guests to access the Retreat Lagoon, a new Blue Lagoon experience where the mineral-rich water flows around the Retreat through a terraced concourse of lava.

The Retreat's Spa Restaurant is designed to offer guests a place to take a break from the spa journey. With the Retreat Lagoon as the restaurant's backdrop, guests can relax in their bathrobes and enjoy seasonal light fare including "Sushi Around Iceland".

Guests can also enjoy shots of thyme and cawberry or algae; beetroot or cold-pressed kale juice; as well as a selection of smoothies based on skyr – an Icelandic dairy offering – including skyr and rhubarb, chia, almond and honey.

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Greg Payne creates wellness retreats

Industry figure Greg Payne is behind a series of four- to seven-night 'transformational' wellness retreats that are due to launch at a hillside hide-away in Provence this month.

Payne, who's worked for leading spa operators such as Aman and InterContinental, has spent the last two years consulting on the project for Villa La Coste. He's brought together specialists in genetics and meditation, cranial sacral therapy, acupuncture, aromatherapy and yoga – who have more than 20,000 hours of experience each in their field.

"The retreats we've chosen are specifically and deliberately branded," said Payne. "Everything we're working with is a traditional modality which is rooted in medical practice." He added that he's intentionally picked experts who don't "do the hotel circuit" and are busy with their own practices.

Running first, from 21-27 April is the Bodhimaya Rest and Restore retreat, which is based on science-based gut-healthy menus, meditation and yoga. Biomarker testing is

offered pre-arrival so the programme can be customised, and focuses can include weight loss, body cleansing, release from stress and burnout or simply resting. Another 10-night Bodhimaya retreat based on genetics and meditation will be available at the end of September.

Body, Mind & Soul, a retreat based on acupuncture, aromatherapy and cranial osteopathy (and including two sessions of each), will be held in May and October.

Arizona spa gets 'Women's Quiet Room'

Sanctuary Spa at Sanctuary on Camelback Mountain Resort & Spa in Scottsdale, Arizona, US, has completed a refurbishment and expansion that has introduced a new look throughout and a new feature, the Women's Quiet Room.

The spa features separate women's and men's spas, with a total of 12 indoor and outdoor treatment rooms and a private, stone-walled outdoor treatment room called Sanctum.

Sanctuary Spa's redesign

is the work of interior designer Lynne Beyer, whose ongoing relationship with the resort has spanned the design of jade bar and Table XII private dining room; the expansion of Sanctuary's signature restaurant, elements; and last year's Spa Casita and Suites remodel. Mark Philp of Allen + Philips Architects is the project architect.

The Women's Spa has been expanded from 12,000 to 13,200 sq ft, and the women's steam room has been doubled in size.

The new windowless, cocoon-like Women's Quiet Room offers spa-goers a tranquil alternative to the more social environment of the women's lounge. Its design is a departure from the rest of the spa – intimate and insular with an emphasis on curves. Sculpted ovals suspended from the 11ft ceiling cradle an 8ft-long light fixture crafted of paper and wood by artist William Leslie and titled "Wave after Wave."

La Valencia adds new sensory spa

California's historic La Valencia Hotel & Spa is set to open a 3,500sq ft wellness sanctuary, as it transforms a 1905-era bungalow into Spa La V, a sensory experience spa and garden.

Located in the San Diego-area town of La Jolla, the hotel was built in 1926 and features 114 bedrooms. Its signature pink exterior and tower have earned it the nickname 'Pink Lady', and it sits overlooking the Pacific coastline and La Jolla Cove.

The spa will feature six treatment rooms, including two couples' suites, as well as a tranquillity lounge with fireplace and intimate Zen deck overlooking a private garden planted with native plants. Connected via a walkway to the sea on the north side of the hotel, the indoor/outdoor oceanview spa will embrace its garden and balconies as treatment spaces, promote social spa-ing and feature results-oriented wellness and beauty therapies.

"Spa La V is an idea whose time has come," said La Valencia's managing director Mark Dibella. "Today's travellers – and the local membership that is sure to build – expect

Bvlgari planning Paris hotel with Antonio Citterio

The hospitality arm of luxury goods giant Bvlgari has announced plans to open a hotel in Paris in 2020, bringing its international collection to eight properties.

Italian design firm Antonio Citterio Patricia Viel and Parisian architects Valode & Pistre are converting a historic building on Avenue George V – adjacent to the Champs Elysees in the famous and fashionable Triangle d'Or area of the French capital – into the 66-room Bvlgari Hotel Paris.

In a bid to boost the hotel's luxury credentials, most of the guestrooms will be suites, and leisure facilities will include Bvlgari spa with a 25-metre pool, a restaurant and bar, and a courtyard garden.

The Bvlgari Hotels & Resorts Group already owns properties in Milan, London, Bali and Dubai.

England's Titanic Spa to eliminate plastic

The Titanic Spa in Huddersfield, UK, has launched a 'no plastic' initiative that will see it completely eliminate the use of plastic bottles, straws and cups. The company was inspired to launch the initiative after Titanic Spa volunteers partnered with Natural Kirklees' Environmental Alliance and pharmaceutical company Thornton & Ross to clear plastic waste from a local pond. Over 500 plastic water bottles were removed, and then later recycled.

The spa has since replaced single-use plastic bottles, cups and straws with recyclable paper alternatives, as well as introduced eco-friendly reusable plastic bottles for guests to keep.

Warrick Burton, MD of Titanic Spa, said: "Plastic waste is a serious problem all over the globe, so we're delighted to have the public's support on this initiative."

Meditation shows long-term gains

Gains in the ability to sustain attention developed through intensive meditation training are maintained up to seven years later, according to a new study published in the *Journal of Cognitive Enhancement*.

The study is based on the Shamatha Project, a major investigation of the cognitive, psychological and biological effects of meditation led by researchers at the University of California, Davis, Center for Mind and Brain.

"This study is the first to offer evidence that intensive and continued meditation practice is associated with enduring improvements in sustained attention and response inhibition, with the potential to alter longitudinal trajectories of cognitive change across a person's life," said first author Anthony Zanesco.

The Shamatha Project examines the effects of two intensive meditation retreats held in 2007 at the Shambhala Mountain Center in



The study examines the effects of meditation retreats held in Colorado

Red Feather Lakes, Colorado, US. Immediately after the study, participants in the meditation retreat showed improvements in attention as well as in general psychological wellbeing and ability to cope with stress.

The new study shows that those gains in attention observed immediately after retreat were partly maintained seven years later, especially for older participants who maintained a more diligent meditation practice over the seven years.

Historic Newcastle baths to be saved

Work has started to renovate Newcastle City Pool and Turkish Baths in Newcastle upon Tyne, UK, following a campaign to save the Grade II listed building.

The £5m (\$7m, €5.7m) renovation will be carried out by leisure charity Fusion Lifestyle, in partnership with design firm Creatability and a number of undisclosed companies.

The baths, which originally opened in 1928, closed to the public in April 2013. Fusion secured planning permission and listed building consent

for the property in 2016, after seeing a community campaign to re-open the baths.

Estimated to be completed in summer 2019, the project includes plans to return the pool and baths to their former glory, including the careful restoration of some of the building's original features, including the 1920s pool tiles, wood-panelled changing rooms and the Turkish baths terrazzo flooring.

The development will also feature a new spa with improved disabled access, as well as a state-of-the-art fitness suite, and conditioning studios.

"The restoration plans will turn this historic 1920s building into a stunning leisure destination fit for 21st-century use," said Ian Cotgrave, managing director of Createability. "This has to be one of the most exciting projects we have worked on to date, and we can't wait to reveal the beautiful facilities to the local community."

Anthony Cawley, operations director at Fusion Lifestyle, added: "We're delighted to start the exciting work to bring the Newcastle City Pool and Turkish Baths back to life."

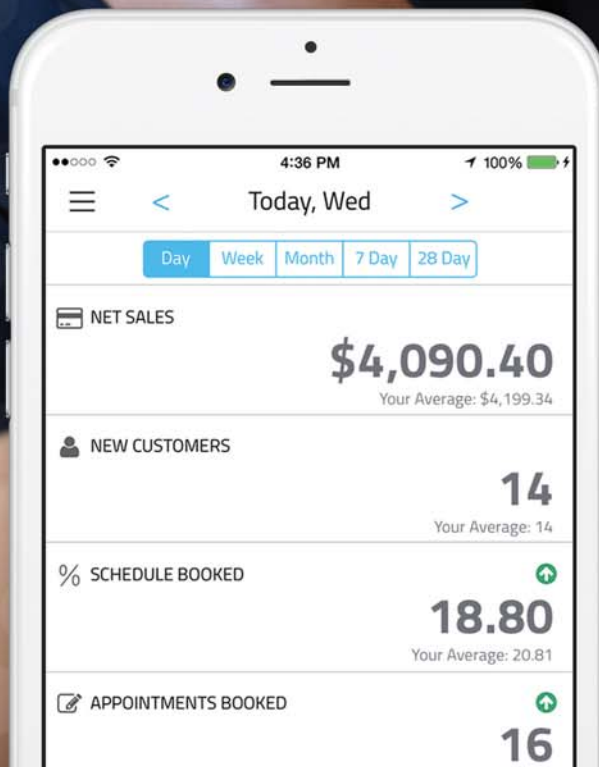
